My Story

I was saved and baptized when I was 9 years old. Although a long time ago, I still remember the feeling when I accepted Jesus and I truly believed I was saved; however, I was still in my "age of innocence" and had not yet eaten from the tree of good and evil. As best I can recall, my "innocence" ended around the time I made a left hand turn on my way to the baseball field and knocked on the door of the House of the Rising Sun which changed my life forever.

For the most part, I raised my kids in Church and I know today it was a good thing to do besides what I have come to find out and believe. Despite what I know about Christianity and the Church now, it did make me and my family aware of Him. But I knew there just wasn't something right. No matter how much "Church" I tried to play, I never really saw or felt the Spirit in my heart and soul. But oddly, I could always feel the Father on my heels even when I was the farthest from Him.

Fast forward to 2020 three to six months before the election. I was a Platinum MAGA Chump card holder. House, car, shirts, hats, etc. pledging allegiance to America, Chump, and the Father (from a once saved always saved wishful thinking kind of way).

I am now proud to say that others see me the way I saw my nephew that day. Out of mind and possibly in a cult (the pastor who baptized me hinted at that when I tried to share what I have now come to see to be the truth). I can relate to how the disciples felt in Acts 5:41. The Truth will certainly set you free.

So, for the next couple of years, I kept my eye on Chump and began researching. I am not going to go into all that I researched because that is a different topic for a different time. For the next couple of weeks, He constantly finished many of my thoughts. I remembered praying where do I start. Instantly, He said Job. The next few sections reflect the knowledge the Father directed me to focus on as we started our walk together.

My Journey with Job

It became very apparent early on in my study of Job, we <u>are</u> Job. And it is not up to us to question who He does or does not show preferential treatment to. The accuser's mission is to prove to the Father we are not worthy to share His glory and love. The accuser is given allowances to prove his point, but the Father ultimately has sovereignty on what the accuser can and can't do. We are not to question Him.

Why are we Here

Next, he led me to focus on developing my own belief systems of why we are here, who He is, who we are.

First and foremost, we are here because I Am can. He is Yah, the Great I Am, and He can do whatever He wants. He is the one and only true living Elohim.

We are here for His pleasure to learn to love Him because He first loved us and to have a genuine relationship with Him in an In the Garden kind of way. We are here because He wanted an earthly family to compliment His heavenly family.

However, he has already had to kick a 1/3 of his heavenly creations out of Heaven due to family drama and such drama disappoints and displeases Him. So, we are tested (we are Job) to see if we are worthy of the reward to grow his heavenly family and spend eternity with Him and his Son.

He gives us free will to determine if we want to spend eternity with Him or if we want to perish (cease to exist and soul destroyed by fire). It is about the reward (eternal life with Yah) not about punishment (eternal conscious torment).

We are here to reflect His image and to glorify and enjoy Him forever.

Who is I AM

I Am is not a Narcissist

Early on, Father guided me to explore the narrative that He demanded we worship Him or He would damn us to conscious torment for eternity in Hell.

Growing up in a Baptist church, I was led to believe we either die and spend eternity in bliss with God (Yahuah) and Jesus (Yahusha) or in eternal torment with Satan and his/her demons. However, I had never really investigated the topic for myself thru extensive biblical research until 2023.

Based on my research, there appears to be three prevalent doctrines regarding Hell:

- 1. Traditionalism (ongoing conscious torment)
- 2. Universalism (all will be saved in the end)
- 3. Conditional Immortality (if follow Christ eternal life, if not perish (annihilated) in lake of fire)

Of course, each doctrine has proponents who say their view is the biblically correct one and every pastor I have ever had preaches eternal conscious torment by hell fire as if it is a fact with irrefutable evidence. However, no one on this side of the veil knows for certain and I find it concerning that

pastors preach their belief with conviction without at least sharing other viewpoints and urging their flock to investigate and discern for themselves. This applies to most doctrines the church teaches. Thus, the deceived become deceivers which is by Satan's deceptive design.

Personally, after extensive Bible study and what I believe has been continuous guidance from the Father, I have come to <u>passionately believe</u> the Conditional Immortality (Annihilationism) viewpoint with an extremely high percentage of confidence based on the scriptures in Appendix 1.

The traditional doctrine/narrative attacks and questions the character of the Father. The teaching of eternal torment paints Yahuah (Yah) as a narcissistic creator who we either bow down and worship or He will consciously punish us for eternity. This serves "Satan" by turning seekers away from Yah to atheism and "religions" that promote false truths because they do not believe a loving God would torment someone for eternity for not believing in Him.

O **Sidebar:** Luciferians justify "Satan's" fall and paint him as a hero for rebelling against Yah for this reason. "Satan" has his minions convinced that he stood up to Father for us.

From Genesis to Revelation, there aren't any scriptures that say Yah will torment sinners consciously for eternity because Yah never said that. The contrasts to everlasting life utilized are die, destruction/destroy, and perish. To say otherwise is slandering Yah and bastardizing his character. <u>John 4:24</u> proclaims that Yah is a Spirt that must be worshipped in spirit and in truth. I do not believe we can have an authentic relationship with the Father if we do not truly know Him and worship Him as He has commanded. We know this is not the Father's character because He never said this (it is not in scriptures).

Many atheists proclaim they don't believe in a "loving Father" who would cast His children into eternal torment for not obeying Him. They state that a god who would do this is not a god worthy of worship and I concur with this. Yah wants children in His family to worship and fellowship Him out of love, not out of fear and manipulation.

Eternal torment results in focusing on the punishment instead of the reward (eternal life in the presence of Yah). Once we acknowledge that Yah gave us life and is simply offering us eternal life with Him if we accept His grace through Yahusha, His true character of love, holiness, righteousness, and justice cannot be debated.

- Sidebar: When you look at <u>John 4:24</u> along with <u>Hosea 4:6</u> and <u>Matthew 7:13-14</u> when Jesus says narrow is the way and <u>few</u> shall find it, I strongly believe he means a FEW. Not just less than half. Because Yah is only offering us a gift (eternal life) and not a punishment (He gave us life and a chance at eternal life and thru free will we determine if we will accept it or not), He can be as selective as He chooses with His love and righteousness without question.
 - So, I believe a few are Noah few, Lot's family few, Job few, etc. and not 20%, 30%, 40%, etc. I am sincerely grateful He has given me a chance at eternal life with Him and a fervent desire for Truth. Regardless of my future, I want to find and share the Truth with anyone who is seeking Him and is for Team Carpenter and against Team Masons/Synagogue of satan.

Knowing that I am not going to be consciously tormented in the lake of fire (when taught we burn in Hell, they did not even get that right), I hunger for the truth in the hopes of sharing it and building Yah's kingdom even if I do not make it.

Many point to the parable found in Luke 16: 19-31 for proof of conscious eternal torment even though the questions/scenario Yahusha was addressing was not regarding what happens when we die.

Please refer to this <u>article</u> that thoroughly and biblically debunks this position in my opinion. It is important to note that I produced the same perspective for the same reasons as the author of this article before I ever came across it. The first time I read this article was as I was writing this. I searched out an article based on my truth for the sake of time. My position regarding eternal conscious torment and the lack thereof was not motivated/influenced by it.

I do believe in Hell (the grave), and I do believe in the lake of fire (the crematory). And I do believe there will be weeping as lost souls wait their turn to be cast into the lake of fire. I am also convinced there will be pain and anger (gnashing of teeth) as souls are annihilated and realize the eternal mistake (nothing is more eternal than no longer existing) they have made. I do not believe souls have physical teeth to grind and I do not believe Yah would consciously torment the average sinner/non-believer.

This is how I interpret John 3:16: He created us to be with Him from nothing and has provided us a way through Yahusha, His Son, to abide with him forever if we show that we love Him and His Son by obeying His commandments. If we do not want to obey and worship Him, He simply puts us back as he found us (nothing). Please refer to the Complete Jewish Bible for what I believe is a more accurate translation of John 3:16. Hebrews 11 defines the type of trust referenced in John 3:16.

Be still and know that he is your Elohim and open your heart to Him. Do you really believe he would give us free will and then torture his creations that do not do His will? The same Elohim that sent His son to bear our shame and take on all of mankind's sin (past, present, and future) so we could be with Him and He could be with us? The lack of scriptures to support this false narrative gives me confidence it is a slanderous attack against the Father's true character and love for his children.

His Name

<u>Exodus 20:7</u> "Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain; for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain." What Age are We In
